Reserve Riesling 2007

100% Riesling, Pemberton, WA

Appearance: Light straw with lime hues.

Nose: Good intensity of aroma, showing lime, floral and citrus notes.

Palate: Crisp palate, showing delicate aromatic citrus fruit and floral flavours with steely, minerally nuances. The palate is balanced with crisp acid and a finish of good length.

Alcohol: 13.0%

Residual sugar: 3g/L (dry)

Cellaring potential: 4 - 5 years

Winemaker's notes: Allowed to achieve optimum ripeness on the vine the fruit was machine harvested in the early morning hours and crushed and pressed immediately upon intake to the winery. All juice and wine handling techniques employed were designed to maximize the retention of primary fruit flavours in order to create a fresh fruit driven wine style.
