



TASTING NOTES

Shiraz Cabernet Merlot 2007

Appearance:	Dense red with crimson hues, brilliant clarity
Nose:	Very intense, ripe black berry, black currant aromas with peppery spice nuances.
Palate:	Rich and full with attractive berry fruit flavours of good concentration. A balanced even palate showing good oak integration with spicy hints lingering on a finish of good length.
Composition:	61% Shiraz, 29% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot – Pemberton
Alcohol:	13.5%
Residual Sugar:	
Sweet/Dry:	Dry
Cellaring Potential:	5 + years
Fining Agent:	Egg White
Preservative:	Sulphur dioxide
Winemaker's Notes:	Made from selected parcels of ultra premium Quality fruit, harvested at optimum ripeness these batches underwent 18 months maturation in one, two and three year old French and American oak with some portions tank fermented on staves.
